

As you may have seen we are making great progress on site. We are currently focussing on the internals of the buildings with our 2nd fix works. We are currently on progress for completion for early spring 2026.

Hale work closely with many employability providers such as Communities for Work +, Newport Youth Academy and PeoplePlus among many others to extend any employment opportunities and experience placements to local residents.

As you may have seen, Hedyn organised a brilliant spring clean by hiring 8 skips which allowed you to dispose of general waste, wood, metal and plastic items.


The key winners of the day were wood and plastic. If you would like to see more events such as these please do get in touch.
